School Day

As we approach the end of term it is time for a gentle reminder that school starts at 8:55am, we do allow children in years 1 to 6 to enter classrooms from 8:45 to allow them a smoother start to the day. A number of children have early morning groups and they need to arrive at 8:30am. All other children should not arrive before 8:45am, unless this has been agreed with their classteacher. We will return to the 8:55 opening of doors if parents continue to drop children into classes too early.

The end of the school day is 3:00pm for Reception and Key Stage 1 and 3:05pm for key stage 2, parents must be on time and should not expect school staff to look after children if they are running late.
